Experience Wide Open Space – Touring Itinerary Echuca ~ Tongala ~ Kyabram ~ Rushworth

(Echuca to Tongala 27kms, about 22 minutes; Tongala to Kyabram 16kms, about 15 minutes; Kyabram to Rushworth 41kms, about 34 minutes; Rushworth to Echuca 73kms, approx. 54 minutes)

Township wall murals are located throughout the Town's centre of Tongala telling stories of the history and shaping of the district. Next stop, a short drive south east to visit Kyabram. Kyabram has vibrant shopping and café culture. Renowned for its dairy and fruit growing, its star attraction is the internationally acclaimed Kyabram Fauna Park.

Kyabram Fauna Park is home to more than 600 native Australian animals and encompasses 55 hectares of open woodland, wetlands and lakes. The Park is open from 9.30am – 5.30pm every day (except Christmas and Good Friday).

Kyabram Town Hall is Campaspe Shire's largest art and exhibition space featuring regional arts and crafts, touring exhibitions, and The Isobel Harvie collection of vintage clothing and objects displayed in ever-changing period settings set in the main Street, Allan St.

And a visit to Kyabram wouldn't be complete without stopping in to meet Megan and her dairy team at The Camel Milk Co. In addition to fresh Camel Milk, you can pick up Camel Milk soaps, lip balms, body butters, liquid soaps and powdered milk. Open Monday to Friday.

Surrounded by the world's largest Ironbark Forest and historic original goldfields, Rushworth retains much of the charm and character from the 1853 gold rush era. This is reflected in its National trust classified streetscape of historic buildings, wide angular street, memorial Rotunda, War Memorial and Palm Avenue. Rushworth is now home to a growing collection of cafes, gift shops and stores selling vintage wares.

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
