Echuca ~ Torrumbarry Weir ~ Lockington ~ Rochester

(Echuca to Torrumbarry 39kms, about 30 minutes; Torrumbarry to Lockington 44kms, about 35 minutes; Lockington to Rochester 24kms, about 20 minutes; Rochester to Echuca 28kms, approx. 24 minutes)

Approximately 22kms North West of Echuca, The Carriages Vineyard and Spa Retreat is nestled among dairy farming land. A visit to this boutique cellar door is strictly by appointment, 549 Kotta Road, Echuca.

Torrumbarry is the gateway to the largest inland island in the country and home to one of the largest weir structures in Australia. The automated weir maintains the Murray River's height at Torrumbarry, where it never varies more than 20mm – creating fantastic conditions for skiing, fishing and all water sports. Visit the Interpretive centre which tells the story of the original Torrumbarry Weir and the “new” Weir, the local irrigation system and the region's native flora and fauna. Open daily: 8am – 5pm.

A visit to Ciurleo's Ice Cream Parlour & Waffle House in Lockington is a must! Stepping inside is just like stepping back in time, inspired by a 1950s retro diner. With 24 flavours to choose from and waffles coated with lashings of chocolate you won't be disappointed. And the front of the building offers the perfect insta-worthy shot: 3-5 Lockington Road, Lockington.

The Rochester community proudly welcomes you to experience its Sports Museum and iconic silo art in the heart of town. The spectacular silo art design by renowned Melbourne artist Jimmy Dvate features locally found threatened species the Squirrel Glider and Azure Kingfisher against a backdrop of the Campaspe River and Rochester's iconic red brick bridge.
